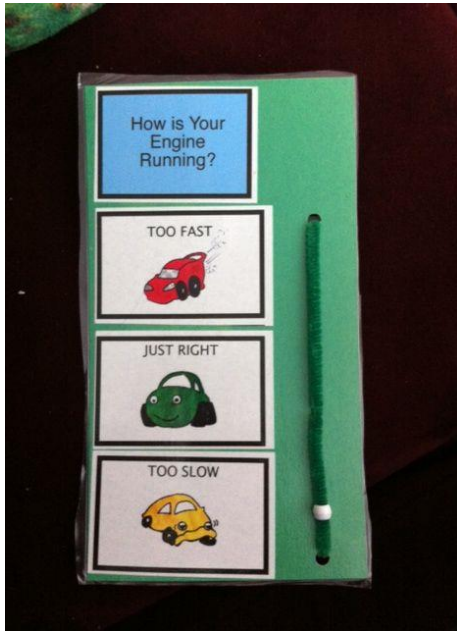
- This registry is set up as a “wedding registry”.

We understand it may not make sense for larger items to be purchased online. Trauma-Informed Design Considerations



Create a sensory space in each home using yoga mats, yoga balls, mini trampoline, rice bucket or sand table/box, fidgets—all different kids, essential oils, sound machine, rocking chair, weighted blankets (that they could even use in their rooms at night).

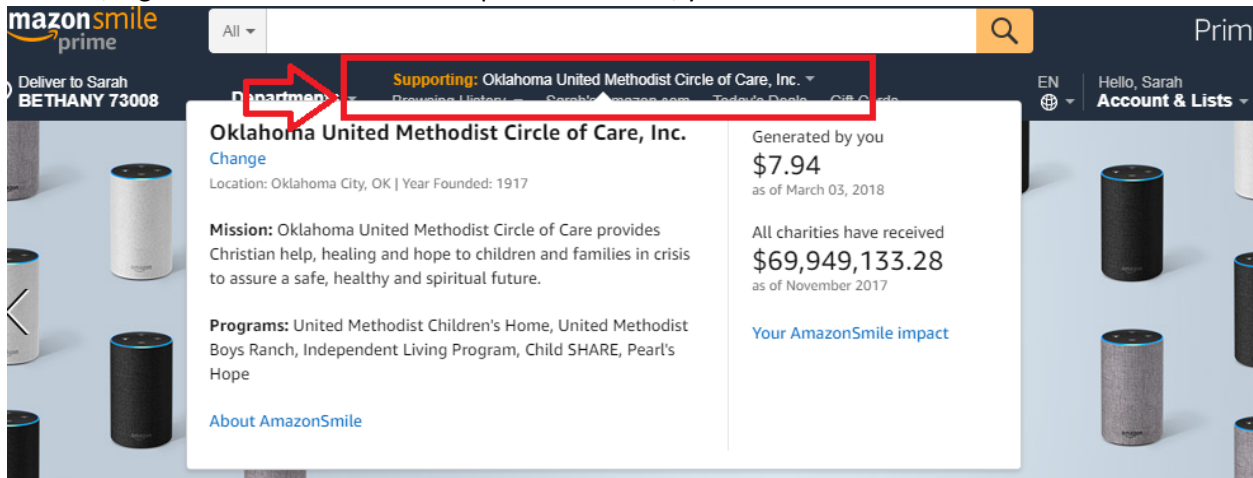
You could also hang engine plates on the walls to help teach regulation. (see photo on left)

Use calming colors for bedroom décor and bedding such as cool blues, light greens, light purples, silver or light grey, earth tones (beige/tan). You can always add color with accent pillows, rugs, etc. that the child might want. Add “comfort” items such as stuffed animals or a big comfy chair/bean bag chair to sit in. Designate a space (or system) that belongs to the child to decorate in their room.

Avoid overcrowding the rooms, especially bedrooms, and do not use fluorescent lighting. Use accent lighting, diffuser with lavender essential oil, and calming music to create a warm ambience.

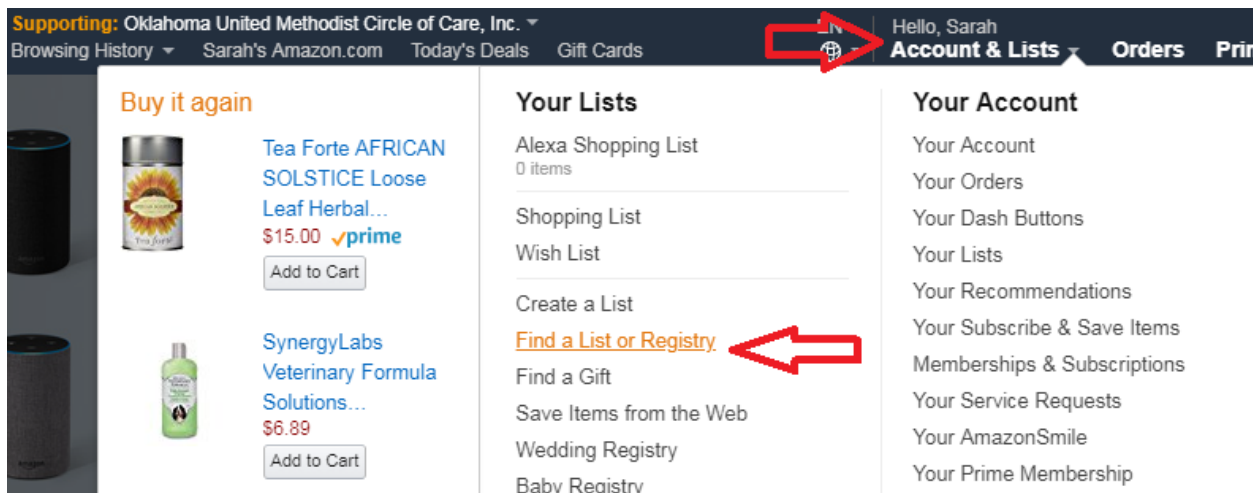
Selecting Your Charity on Smile.Amazon.com
